

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO B.E. COURSES

ELIGIBILITY AS PER TAMILNADU GOVT. NORMS

QUALIFYING EXAM: A pass in HSC (Academic) / CBSE / Pre - degree - Plus Two level / Equivalent with minimum eligibility marks in mathematics , physics and chemistry.

OR

A pass with minimum eligibility marks in one of the HSC (Vocational Stream) with engineering / Technology as Vocational subjects and any one or two of the related subject like mathematics physics or chemistry.

OR

Any other equivalent qualification approved by the State Board of Technical Education and Training / Higher Secondary Board of Tamil Nadu, and Universities in Tamil Nadu.

MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY MARKS:

A) For SC / ST candidates a pass in the qualifying examination will suffice and the minimum marks are the same as the passing minimum for HSC and diploma exams of the state of Tamil Nadu.

B) Candidates belonging to communities other than SC / ST should have obtained the following minimum marks as per Tamil Nadu Government norms.

FORWARD COMMUNITY CANDIDATES:

For Forward community Candidates from Tamilnadu, the minimum percentage of marks for admission to B.E. or B. Tech . Degree.

HSC (academic) / cbse / Pre - degree / Plus Two and other equivalent examinations A minimum of 50% in Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry put together.

BACKWARD COMMUNITY CANDIDATES:

A minimum of 45% in Mathematics, physics and chemistry

MOST BACKWARD COMMUNITY CANDIDATES:

A minimum of 40% in mathematics, physics and chemistry.

CANDIDATES FROM OTHER STATES:

1. Candidates from other states irrespective of their community, will be considered only as OC (other community) for the purpose of considering the minimum eligibility marks. All other state candidates who have scored marks above 50% are eligible.
2. All candidates except CBSE students who have passed the qualifying exam from the states should produce an Eligibility certificate from Anna University before admission. (refer the requirements for eligibility certificates)

ELIGIBILITY AS PER AICTE NORMS

Eligibility For NRI / Minority / Lapsed Quota Seats

A pass in HSC (academic) / CBSE / pre- degree / plus 2 level or equivalent with an average 50% marks in Mathematics, physics and chemistry in single appearance . Candidates who pass their qualifying examination through instant / supplemental / compartmental examination will not be eligible for admission. All students must appear for the common entrance test conducted by the consortium of recognized associations of all self financing engineering colleges in Tamil nadu.

HSC - Vocational Candidates:

Candidates who are qualifies with HSC (vocational stream) with engineering / technical vocational subjects and any one or two of the related subjects like mathematics, physics or chemistry are also eligible under AICTE norms provided they have passed their qualifying examinations in SINGLE sitting and obtained eligibility marks.

Lateral Entry Scheme (Direct II year BE / B. Tech)

Science Graduates with 50% aggregate and studied Mathematics as ancillary subject are eligible. Diploma holders from government approved institutions with minimum eligibility marks are eligible for direct admission to second year B.E. /B. Tech courses. A pass in the 3 years diploma examination conducted by state Technical Education Irrespective of states with a minimum of

- 50 % marks in the final year examination (for non-semester pattern)
- 50% marks in the fifth and sixth semester examination (for semester pattern)

In order to make it convenient for the students seeking admission to Infant Jesus Group of Engineering Colleges, the Infant Jesus Educational trust adapts common policies and procedures for admission. This is irrespective of the course. Policies enumerated herein are subject to change.

1. Request for admission to a course should be made only in the Registration Form which will be issued in the Office or Applications may be submitted through this website.

2. Registration Form should be handed over to the Admission Officer along with a Xerox copy of the mark sheet of qualifying examination attested by a Gazetted Officer.

3. All students including Other States seeking admission to any course, should attach a Xerox copy of the mark sheet of qualifying examination and proof of age, duly attested, along with the Registration Form. The candidate should produce an authentic certificate indicating the corresponding marks for each grade in mark sheet. Short-listed candidates based on the overall ranking of qualifying examination marks for B.E / B.Tech. / M.B.A admission will receive a call letter for counseling along with parents. These candidates shall meet the Director and Principal with the receipt for the full payment of fees in the form of a DD drawn in favour of "INFANT JESUS COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING" payable at "TIRUNELVELI", No cheques will be accepted.

4. If any candidate is found to have secured admission by fraudulent methods like presentation of forged certificates, cheques etc., he/she will be dismissed from the college at any time during the course and will forfeit entire fees paid.

5. Students are expected to submit the following to the Admission Officer and get a letter of admission to meet the Principal.

- 1. Birth Certificate
- 2. Nativity Certificate
- 3. Community Certificate
- 4. Transfer Certificate
- 5. Counseling call Letter
- 6. SWS Seat Allotment Letter
- 7. 7 Nos. Stamp Size Colour Photos
- 8. Baptism Certificate (for Christian Students)

NOTE: The admission of other state students shall be confirmed only after the submission of eligibility certificate from Anna University by the student.

6. Students who have opted for Hostel accommodation will report to the Manager of the Hostel and submit the prescribed application for Hostel accommodation and get the Hostel allotment after remitting the fee. Each student has to give an undertaking that he/she shall abide by the rules and regulations for the hostel.

Note: Fee should be remitted only in the college office. As per Anna University direction no student shall be permitted to attend classes until he/she remits the full fee for the academic year.
